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Reading/Language Arts Notes

First grade worked on learning the spelling pattern of changing the "y" to an "i" when adding -ier or -est. They also learned about idioms. In LA, first grade began learning about identifying topics in paragraph and supporting versus non supporting sentences.

Second graders worked on words have the short u sound but is spelled with an a or an e.

They also reviewed more contractions and worked with the prefix -un. In L.A., second grade began reviewing the writing process and will be creating a 3 point expository paragraph.
