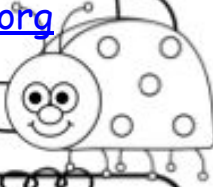


# Mrs. Lee's Week 26 Newsletter

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## Reading/Language Arts Notes

Both first and second graders participated in a mini-book club this last week. Students were divided into three reading groups and read a short book: "Oscar Otter", "Wagon Wheels", or "Bug Lab." Each group worked on using their reading strategies to read words and comprehend their reading. We also focused on story elements: characters, setting, problem, and solution.

In LA, first grade continued working with identifying topics in paragraph and supporting versus non supporting sentences.

Second grade continued writing their 3-point expository paragraphs.
