BOSE Notes: Below are notes from the April 9 BOSE meeting:

- 1. <u>Classroom Visitations.</u> BOSE visited classrooms on March 5. The consensus of the BOSE members is that we are blessed to have such an excellent and dedicated teaching staff.
- 2. <u>Dollars for Scholars.</u> Trinity is participating in the Belle Plaine Dollars for Scholars program. BOSE chair, Gary Bandel, will award a Belle Plaine graduate a scholarship on behalf of Trinity Church and School. The criteria of the scholarship is that the graduate be a member in good standing at Trinity, have a "B" average or better, be attending a school or technical program in the coming year, and have provided at least twenty hours of community service.
- 3. Grades 5-6 Teacher Call. Because Mr. Raith returned the call to teach Grades 5-6 in the coming year, BOSE voted to request a graduate from the MLC Assignment Committee. (The MLC Assignment Committee is made up of Martin Luther College staff and the WELS Conference of Presidents.) The Trinity Voting Assembly asked BOSE to make the request of MLC should the call be returned. The deadline for making such a request is May 1. There would not be enough time to make a call from the field and still consider the Assignment Committee if needed.
- 4. <u>Telling the Next Generation.</u> Two BOSE members along with seven other Trinity members attended an Outreach workshop at St. Peter Lutheran Church in St. Peter on Saturday, April 6. The purpose of the workshop is to help churches and schools develop a harvest strategy for gathering and retaining members. Pastor Bentz is helping to lead the effort here at Trinity. - 5. <u>ECE Licensing Update.</u> We have passed our building, fire, and health inspections. The principal is working on the policies and procedures that are needed to meet the requirements of a licensed center.
